VI. Update on Proposed Revisions to Regulation No. 7 as Part of the Early Action Compact for Ozone

Staff will brief the Council on recent developments regarding proposed revisions to Regulation No. 7, which addresses ozone-precursor emissions from the oil and gas industry. A hearing before the Air Quality Control Commission is scheduled for November 17 and 18.

VII. Implementation Plan for HB 1302 and Proposed Revisions to Regulation No. 11 Concerning Additional Model Year Exemptions

Staff from the Air Pollution Control Division will brief the Council on the status of the plan to implement provisions of HB 1302, which mandates expansion of the Clean Screen program and development of a high-emitter program. Division staff will also address a proposed revision to Regulation No. 11 that increases the number of model year exemptions in the current emissions testing program and the relationship of this proposal to the HB1302 plan.

Action: Provide feedback on HB 1302 plan and develop position on proposed revisions to Regulation No. 11

VIII. Update on Clean Air Fleets Diesel Retrofit Program

Staff will update the Council on the status of the Clean Air Fleets program, including past diesel retrofit efforts as well as future plans for additional diesel emission reduction projects.
